At a minimum, a Strong’s Concordance is required.

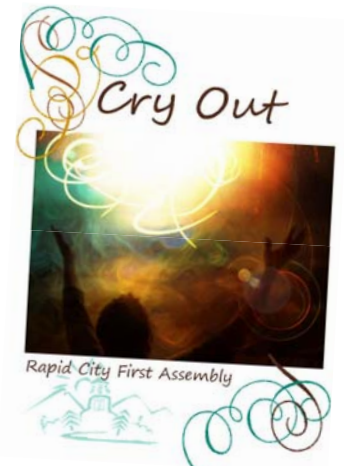
